Number of invisible hinges to be used in function of door weight and a maximum door of 2000 mm (height) x 1000 mm (width) according to EN 1935:

2 hinges (**) max. 40 kg 3 hinges max. 50 kg

(**): In order to maintain the perpendicular line of the door panel, the use of a minimum of 3 hinges is recommended.

The use of more than 4 hinges is not recommended; please contact us when this should be necessary.



Adjusted door weight
According to EN 1935 door closers increase the loading on door hinges and their rate of wear. For proper calculation this should be taken in to account.

Door closer: increase the door weight by 20 %

Door closer with back check: increase the door weight by 75 %
